ANNUAL FLUSHING NOTICE

Sandy Point will be completing our annual water main flushing March 8-12 and March 15-19. Flushing will start in the Heights.

Water main flushing is an annual preventative maintenance activity to help maintain water quality. Sandwich Boards will be displayed as early as March 5th to remind everyone.

As we flush the water main in your area, you may experience a temporary reduction in water pressure. You may also notice some slight discoloration or change in the taste/odor in your water caused by the mineral deposits we are flushing from our mains.

These conditions are normal during flushing activities and are only temporary. If you should experience any of these conditions, it is recommended you flush the pipes of your home by simply running cold water through one or more faucets, inside or outside your home until your water runs clear. It is also suggested to refrain from washing your laundry if you are experiencing any of these temporary water issues.

your agent (contractor or plumber for example) may
turn them on or off. To request that your water be
turned on or off, call the office during regular
business hours. We ask that you please keep water
meters clear of debris and plant growth. During times
of water emergencies, it is imperative that our water
technicians and staff can locate and access your
water meter quickly. When meters are not accessible,
it delays our response time to help remedy an
emergency. REMINDER: If you notice unusual water
around your meter box or property, please call the
office or the water emergency cell phone!
