Having meter boxes easy to find and readily available aids the Water Department in cases of water emergencies and repairs.

Outdoor Burning Restrictions

A reminder that yard and beach debris fires are no longer permitted in Fire District #17. Beach and recreational campfires consisting of either charcoal or split dry firewood **only** and in an approved enclosure are permitted. The fines and fees for responding to illegal burns are very expensive. Know what the regulations are before you burn. WATER METERS are the property of the Sandy Point Improvement Company and neither you nor your agent (contractor or plumber for example) may turn them on or off. To request that your water be turned on or off, call the office during regular business hours. We ask that you please keep water meters clear of debris and plant growth. During times of water emergencies, it is imperative that our water technicians and staff can locate and access your water meter quickly. When meters are not accessible, it delays our response time to help remedy an emergency. REMINDER: If you notice unusual water around your meter box or property, please call the office or the water emergency cell phone!
