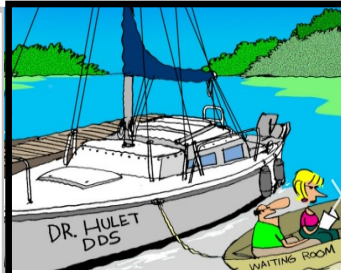

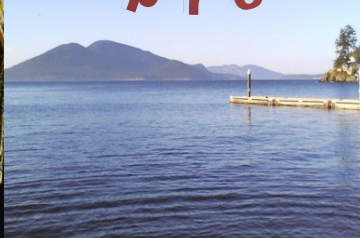

Island of Cypress



Cypress, named after what explorers mistakenly thought were Cypress trees on shore, is one of the San Juan's largest uninhabited islands. The island offers 5,500 acres of rich forest and grasslands, along with nearly 20 miles of beautiful hiking trails. Almost the entire island is either a Natural Resources Conservation Area or Natural Area Preserve Lands—allowing the island to preserve its natural beauty and protect local wildlife. Cypress's main attraction is its hiking trails and small swimming lakes. Stop at either Eagle Harbor or Pelican Beach (both have mooring balls), and then hike up to Eagle Cliff—the perfect place to catch sweeping views of the San Juans and spot bald eagles. Keep in mind, this trail is closed Feb. 1-July 15 to protect nesting raptor and their young

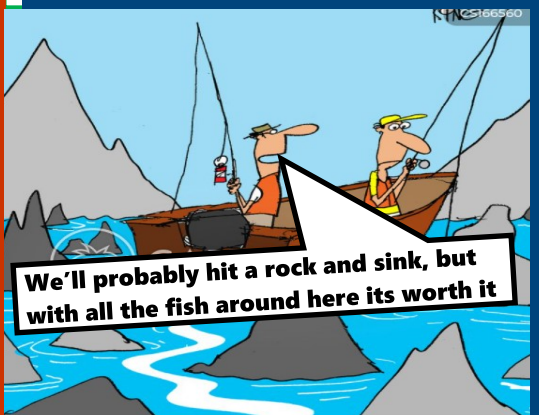
