Cold Weather Recommendations

We have learned a lot during our recent cold snap. Many utilities including ours, struggled to maintain service through the extreme weather event. We also learned some things that would be helpful for property owners and utilities as our community partners to weather future storms.

- 1. Keep house heated to a minimum of 65 degrees.

 Temperatures inside walls can be substantially colder than the interior. Checking that fireplaces, wood stoves, and electrical heating are working properly can help with this issue.
- 2. Check location for main water shutoff at house, and how it works. If there is no shutoff at house, we strongly recommend in the installation of one immediately.
- During extremely cold temperatures, allowing hot and cold faucets to run momentarily can ensure that pipes are not frozen and do not freeze through. Do not leave water running or dripping

continuously for extended periods of time, even a small continuous drip can lead to exorbitant water usage.

Make sure house is regularly checked for signs of leaks, if away for extended periods of time. Have neighbors come and check your house when you are away.

5.Please turn water off at your house if you will be gone for an extended period. We also recommend turning hot water tank off. Please call the office if you want water turned off outside your house.

- 6. Make sure all pipes are wrapped, especially if they are located on an outside wall.
- 7. Put draft snakes on windowsills, between window frames, and against doors.
- 8. Keep drapes and blinds closed, except when windows are in direct sunlight to reduce drafts.
- 9. Put insulation cups on outside hose bibs.
- 10. Check www.oursandypoint.com for notifications on our utility and sign up for the email alert system by calling or contacting the office at office@oursandypoint.com.
