

Water main flushing is a biannual preventative maintenance activity to help maintain water quality. Sandwich Boards will be displayed as early as May 1st as a reminder. As we flush the water main in your area, you may experience a temporary reduction in water pressure. You may also notice some slight discoloration or change in the taste/odor in your water caused by the mineral deposits we are flushing from our mains. These conditions are normal during flushing activities and are only temporary. If you should experience any of these conditions, it is recommended you flush the pipes of your home by simply running cold water through one or more


