We have received both culvert permits and a property address from the county and the septic system design is underway. Our volunteer project Manager Bob Cecile continues to move things through the permitting process. In an effort to borrow as little as possible for construction the district is funding the engineering, architectural, stormwater, and septic tank work out of our reserve account.
