Outdoor Burning Restrictions

The Fire Department would like to remind resident that all yard and beach debris fires are illegal in Fire District #17. Only beach and recreational campfires consisting of either charcoal or split dry firewood and in an approved enclosure are permitted. It is important to know the regulations as the fire department issues fines and fees for responding to illegal fires and they are very expensive.
