Are your house numbers visible from the street? Is it time to replace those old faded out mailbox numbers with new ones? Help us to find you in an emergency.

Outdoor Burning Restrictions

With the burn ban ending the fire department would like to remind residents that all yard and beach debris fires are still illegal in Fire District #17.

Gas weed burning devices are also prohibited. Only recreational camp and beach fires consisting of either charcoal or split dry firewood and in an approved enclosure are permitted. Outdoor gas

fireplaces are encouraged and are permitted year round. It is important to know the regulations and current burn ban status as the fire department issues fines and fees for responding to illegal fires and they are very expensive. For more information stop by the Sucia
